Update on MERS Transition

Anne Campbell (HR Dir) updated the Board on the transition from our current retirement plan provider, Principal Financial to Municipal Employees' Retirement System (MERS) covering the following:

- 1.) There are no surrender or termination fees from Principal to the Authority or its employees.
- 2.) The MERS defined contribution plan for full-time/administrative staff will reflect the immediate vesting schedule that we currently have with Principal Financial.
- 3.) In order to be compliant with the MERS plan document, all part-time/paid-on-call new hires (hired after the plan adoption date) must participate in the defined contribution plan. Those who choose <u>not</u> to participate in the 457 and defined contribution match program; BAFA will contribute \$1.00/month into the employee's defined contribution. If and when, MERS changes their plan document removing this requirement, a proposed amendment will be presented to the Board to remove this \$1.00/month allocation into the employee's defined contribution plan.
- 4.) Attorney Howard Shifman is currently reviewing the plan documents.
- 5.) Transition expected to be complete by October 1st, 2017.

The Board reached a general consensus on the change and will formally vote on the MERS plan adoption at the September 14th board meeting.

Our 9/11 Memorial Ceremony will be held on the evening of Monday, September 11^{th.}

Anne Campbell (HR Dir) is working on hiring 13 paid-on-call firefighters which will start at the end of this month and 4 more paid-on-call firefighters will start at the end of November.

There are 5 candidates in the running for the Fire Marshal position. We will be conducting oral boards next Thursday.

The candidates for the Fire Protection Specialist position will be taking their written exam at the end of this month.
