### Good of the Order

Staffing has been tough in the last couple of weeks with a number of our employees being forced to quarantine due to Covid-19 exposures; but Chief O'Brian stated that the authority is beginning to see a downward trend in those Covid related exposures.

Chief O'Brian and Deputy Chief Evans have been working with Livingston County's Emergency Operations Center and EMS on the roll-out of the Covid-19 vaccine. They are anticipating that the 1-A group (Hospitals & Healthcare providers) could receive the vaccine in the next 7-10 days and our staff which is in the 1-B group could be phased in by the end of January 2021 after which it would be rolled out to the general population.

Plans are moving along on Station 33. We are still working out the easement issue with the Livingston County Road Commission but once that gets settled, we'll proceed with the civil engineering. Our hope is to have plans ready for approval by the Brighton Township planning commission at the February 2021 meeting.

Fire Marshal Boisvert has been working diligently on updating the ordinances. He has reached out to the Livingston County Building Department as well as staff from the three municipalities to get their feedback.

We took possession of our new Engine 30 in November and it is now in service. We expect to receive the new Engine 35, which will replace the engine that was totaled, some time in February 2021.
