#### Good of the Order

Station 33 construction bid documents were due by June 4<sup>th</sup>. Of the dozen or so bids received, staff narrowed it down to four candidates which are set to be interviewed in the coming weeks. We are anticipating a September/October 2021 start date with a one-year completion timeline. The attorneys are still working on resolving some easement issues.

The new Engine 34 is expected to arrive next week.

Staff has been busy with unusually high call volumes. We've had as many as 20 calls in one day. We've also seen an increase in the number of structure fires.

We have several employees out on injury and are therefore resorting to offering temporary full-time positions to help staff the stations.

We are receiving parade registrations and busy making preparations for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade.
