Request Approval of Snow Removal Services with Clearwater Property Service

This request is to authorize the Fire Chief to enter into a snow removal contract with a qualified bidder for 2020/21 snow season.

The cost of salt has gone down slightly from last year. It is estimated that our sites require snow removal 12-15 times by snowplowing and salting, then 60 applications with only salt. In the 2018/19 season the Authority received multiple bids and contracted with CPS.

This request covers the current year at \$48,620 which is consistent with the FY 2020 pricing.

- Developing of process and procedures for COVID-19 related educational absences.
